Massillon Heritage Foundation Receives Ohio History Fund Grant

The Massillon Heritage Foundation is pleased to be one of only thirteen organizations statewide to receive an Ohio History Fund Grant. The foundation will receive \$17,900 to continue the restoration of Five Oaks Historic Mansion. This grant will enable the foundation to initiate interior restoration by repairing damaged plaster and paint in the mansion's parlor, library, music room and second floor hallway.

Matching Funds Needed

Ohio History Fund grants are matching grants and the foundation will be required to contribute 40% of the total project cost that is anticipated to exceed \$30,000. This translates into \$12,000 that the foundation must raise in order to receive the state funds. Plans are being finalized for a capital campaign to raise the necessary funds.

Ohio History Fund

The history fund is a competitive grant-matching program that is one of four "tax check-off" funds found on Ohio tax-payers' income tax forms. "The fund helps us share and preserve Ohio's story by supporting local projects and programs in communities throughout the state" said Burt Logan, Executive Director and CEO for the Ohio History Connection.
